## USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

### **Local Rules**

- 1. Flower Beds, Protective Fences, Restrooms, Staked Trees, Wrong Greens, and Unpaved Roads Drop within one club length of nearest point of relief no closer to the hole. No penalty.
- **2. Stones in Bunkers** Loose impediments in bunkers are considered movable obstructions. Proceed under Rule 24-1.
- **3. Flood Control Channels** Channels are considered lateral water hazards. Balls coming to rest on the opposite side of a parallel channel are deemed to be in the hazard.
- **4. Embedded Balls** Embedded balls through the green may be lifted, cleaned and placed as near as possible to the original lie no closer to the hole. No penalty.

## **Course Markings**

- Out of Bounds Out of bounds is defined by boundary fences, driving range fences, and white stakes.
- Hazards Water hazards are defined by yellow stakes. Lateral hazards are defined by red stakes. If no stakes are present, the margin of the hazard is defined by the water's edge and shall be considered a lateral hazard.
- Yardage Markers All on-course yardages are measured to the center of the green.

# **Playing Guidelines**

- Play "Ready Golf" at all time. Keep up with the group in front of you.
- · Repair ball marks, replace divots and rake sand in bunkers.
- Cards must remain on path near all tees and greens. Please keep carts on path on all par 3's unless otherwise marked.
- Golfers are responsible for injury or damage caused by errant shots.
